

### **Allotment of Research Guide**

Allotment of Research Guide will be done by the respective University Departments/Research Centres as per the following guidelines:

On the basis of the interview, allotment of Research Guides for selected candidates shall be decided by the University Departments/Research Centres in a formal manner depending on the number of candidates per teacher, the available specialization among the Research Guides and the research interest as indicated during interview by the candidates. The allotment/allocation of Research Guide shall not be left to the individual candidate or guide. Guide-wise quota will be declared. Reservation policy will be observed at the time of allotment. The reservation will be followed as per guide basis e.g. (out of eight vacancies, four should be open and four should be reserved category)

While granting admission to candidates to Ph.D. programmes, the University Departments/Research Centres will follow the State Reservation Policy. Foreign candidates will be treated at par with Open Category for admission.

Only one foreign student will be permitted per guide.

Head of the University Departments/Research Centres will ensure the allotment of guide(s) within 3 months from the date of selection of the candidates.

### **Application:**

Every person, if he/she is otherwise eligible and qualifies as per above conditions and desirous of doing research work for the Ph.D. degree shall face the interview before the Committee constituted for the purpose. All such candidates will apply to respective University Departments/Research Centres for registration for the purpose of interview. Candidates exempted from Entrance Examination as per Clause 2 (a) shall also have to register their candidature with the respective University Departments/Research Centre.
